### **1446. Planning Applications**

10/00190/FUL            715 Bath Road, Burnham            B. South & Dorney  
Part single storey/part two storey side and rear extension.  
The Parish Council OBJECTS to this application and consider it to be contrary to policy H11(b) and (d) of the Local Plan. The extension would adversely affect the amenities of the adjacent property, No. 717, through overlooking, overdominance, obtrusiveness and loss of daylight. From the plans submitted the development does not appear to be one metre from the flank boundary.
