Burnham Parish Council are dedicated to the community, and we continue to expand our work, and improve our facilities, for the Burnham community, and the surrounding residents who benefit from our services.

Through the hard work of Burnham Park Hall’s dedicated team, we’re delivering more events, and making them bigger and better every year. We are also investing heavily in our parks and playgrounds, the football pitches at the George Pitcher Memorial Ground, and other facilities such as street lights and public toilets.

We continue to broaden our horizons. We are looking to employ an Economic Development Manager to help revitalise the High Street and other retail areas. We’re also leading on many community projects such as developing a neighbourhood plan; a village museum; improving neglected public footpaths; coordinating community litter picks; and campaigning for improvements to the village’s roads and infrastructure.

Despite our extensive programme of events, improvements, and investment, we have managed to keep the increase of our precept to 2%, below the current rate of inflation.

For 2019/20, the weekly contribution made by a tax band D household to our work will be £2.07, (£108.00 total per year), and will be spent as follows:

- 61p – staffing and administration
- 19p – Burnham Park Hall running costs and in-house events
- 54p – recreation facilities, public conveniences, and street lights
- 46p – loan repayments for the building of Burnham Park Hall
- 17p – Capital improvement projects, community events and grants
- 10p – rebuilding Council reserves
